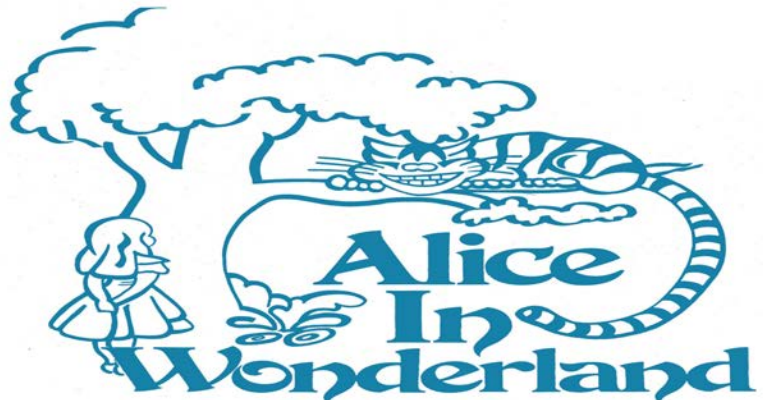

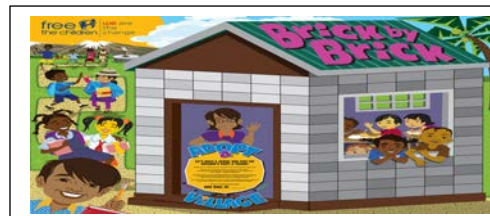
## Have you considered APPRENTICESHIP?



Grades 6-12 students had many good questions for Paul Blankestijn of the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission during his presentation at Pangman School on Dec. 16. Students learned that apprenticeship means you spend 85% of the time learning a trade on-the-job while earning a wage, and 15% learning in school. Paul indicated that most employers prefer to hire employees who have Grade 12.



Dan Hardern from our school division also spoke to our high school students on Dec. 16. He outlined the opportunities our students have to explore career options in the trades while earning Grade 12 credits. Details on SECPD website.
